

CLEARANCES POLICY

We are happy to sign clearance agreements covering all of our generic props. These items are clearly labeled with a "C" immediately following their 6 digit prop number.

We do not sign clearance agreements on props labeled with "K" or "X" after the 6 digit prop number. On these items, productions are required to make independent evaluations.

"K" indicates items we believe to be cleared &/or items we believe to be in the public domain. But as we do not own explicit rights to them, productions must make independent evaluations.

"X" indicates Vintage signs, Antiques, or found objects and are NOT cleared art.

PROP NUMBERING SYSTEM

The 6 digit number identifies the signs' backings.

- 100- (Authentic Vintage Sign)
- 125-001 thru 125-499 (Faux Vintage Sign on wood vintage style cabinet)
- 125-500 thru 125-999 (Faux Vintage Sign on metal vintage style cabinet)
- 150- Neon mounted on plexiglass
- 175- Neon mounted on a studio flat (1x3 with luan skin)
- 250- Un-mounted neon
- 300- Equipment rentals
- 900- Assemblage Prop – made by combining multiple props.

Some props have an additional set of letters following a dash

Example: 125-600C-NT

The final set of letters following a dash appears on some but not all props

- NT (Transformer not included)
- AN (This prop animates)
- ANP (This prop can animate with the use of additional rental equipment)
